

DAY 31: THE GREATEST MOMENT IN HUMAN HISTORY

I. THE SPIRIT OF PROPHECY, THE TESTIMONY OF JESUS, AND THE MYSTERY OF GOD

And the angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven 6 and swore by him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and what is in it, the earth and what is in it, and the sea and what is in it, that there would be no more delay, 7 but that in the days of the trumpet call to be sounded by the seventh angel, the mystery of God would be fulfilled, just as he announced to his servants the prophets. ([Revelation 10:5-7](#))

- A. The prophets have been declaring the Mystery of God since the beginning of the prophetic spirit ([v. 7](#))
 - 1. The Spirit of Prophecy is the Testimony of Jesus ([Revelation 19:11](#))
- B. The Spirit of Prophecy, the Testimony of Jesus, and the Mystery of God are interconnected

II. THE SEVENTH TRUMPET

- A. We must conclude that the Seventh Trumpet is of extreme significance because with its sounding:
 - 1. The Mystery of God is complete ([Revelation 10](#))
 - 2. Judgement comes ([Revelation 11](#))
- B. The Kingdom comes when the King comes and begins to reign

III. 1 CORINTHIANS 15

- A. Flesh and blood cannot inherit the Kingdom ([v. 50](#))
- B. Not all of us will die ([v. 51](#))
- C. “The dead will be raised at the last trumpet” ([v. 52](#))
- D. If you are alive at the sounding of the last trumpet, you will not die ([v. 53-58](#))
 - 1. We who are mortal receive immortal bodies

IV. 1 TIMOTHY 3

- A. “Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness” ([v. 16](#))
- B. The Lord, who is already immortal, takes on a mortal body
- C. The mystery of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit

V. 2 THESSALONIANS 2

- A. "...that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first," (v. 3)
 - 1. Antichrist must be revealed
- B. "For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work." (v. 7)
- C. When the restraint is taken away, then the Antichrist is revealed, and then the mystery of iniquity is revealed
- D. The Day of The Lord doesn't come until the mystery of iniquity runs its course
 - 1. The incarnation of iniquity must come to fruition before the seventh trumpet can sound

VI. COLOSSIANS 1

- A. ...the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints. To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory **of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.** (Colossians 1:26-27)
- B. The indwelling of Christ himself, dwelling inside of you, is your hope of glory
- C. This will be actualized at the sounding of the seventh trumpet

VII. EPHESIANS 1-3

- A. "To unite all things in Him, things in heaven and things on earth." (Ephesians 1:10)
- B. At the sounding of the seventh trumpet, God will bring together heaven and earth
- C. At this bringing together, we will be changed
- D. A component of this mystery involves both Jew and Gentile (Ephesians 2:11-22)
- E. The mystery is that Gentiles are included into the Covenant Family through the blood of Israel's Messiah (Ephesians 3:6)

VIII. ROMANS 11

- A. "A partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in" (v. 25)
- B. The destinies of the Jew and the Gentile are interconnected

IX. MATTHEW 11-12

- A. Something hidden and something revealed
- B. Jesus reveals his mysteries to those who are "like children" (v. 25)
- C. If you have hunger and humility, the mysteries of God will be revealed to you (Matthew 13)
